SUCCESSFUL FLOOD PREVENTION EXHIBITION

A public exhibition of the plans for the new flood prevention route through the Fishermen's Car Park took place at the Village Hall.

The original route along The Strand was controversial and divided Attenborough, much to the dismay of residents. Local Conservatives joined campaigners to oppose the route and to protect the Village Green, including the cricket and football pitches. "None of us wanted to jeopardise the overall scheme which will protect 16,000 homes and businesses," Eric Kerry said, adding, "during the original planning meeting, I spoke out for a better route, as it was clearly still a possibility by working with the Environment Agency. Labour gave up on this and just walked away from the debate. It just shows what can be done when you represent people and stay true to your beliefs."
