SEVERE THREAT TO GREEN BELT

Despite the Coalition Government removing the housing targets set by the previous Labour Government, the Labour led administration at Broxtowe are determined to build over 6,000 houses. This means that large swathes of green-belt will be built on. Proposals include 700 houses at Woodhouse Way plus other sites in Watnall. Imagine the traffic that will be generated especially when you consider that the City Council are hoping to develop up to 500 houses at the side of the Nottingham Business Park. PARKING PROBLEMS AT STRELLEY

A survey of residents on the Wimpy Estate organised by the County Council at the request of County Councillor Philip Owen resulted in only 21% of surveys being returned. This is insufficient to proceed with a residents parking scheme. Certain parts of College Way will be protected by double yellow lines which hopefully, will ease some of the worst of the parking problems.

PARKING PROBLEMS AT HORSENDALE

Several residents have approached me expressing disquiet at the appalling parking of some vehicles at school drop off and collection times. The main worry is one of road safety and concern surrounding what would happen if an ambulance or fire engine needed to use any of the roads around Horsendale Primary. The roads worst affected are Assarts Road, Drummond Drive, Horsendale Avenue and Vernon Drive.

One possible solution is to put **time specific** single yellow lines down either just one side or both sides of parts of the above roads. **Time specific** controls would exclude parking from 3 to 4 pm. The major disadvantage to this type of restriction is that residents or their visitors would not be able to park outside their properties during these times. Initially I am conducting a consultation survey with residents of the affected roads to gauge their views. If residents want time specific yellow lines I will then contact the Nottinghamshire County Council highways department to progress the proposals.
