KIMBERLEY ROAD BUS LANE

The removal of this bus lane is imminent. County Councillor Philip Owen commented, "this bus lane has been a danger since it was installed and allows irresponsible motorists the freedom to speed down Kimberley Road. The irony is that at best it has only saved a matter of a few seconds on a bus journey but residents have had to suffer the problems 24 hours a day. I hope that it will be much easier and safer for pedestrians to cross the road when it is removed".

MAIN ROAD WATNALL

WATNALL GYPSUM MOUNTAIN

Many of you have contacted us concerned about the gypsum mountain that has appeared in Watnall. Cllr Derek Burnett, Anna Soubry and myself had a meeting recently at Fernwood Fuels. The outcome was as follows:

Fernwood have bought a new bowser and tractor to ensure dust is kept to an absolute minimum.

Broxtowe Borough Council's Environmental Health Department will continue to monitor the situation and work with Fernwood to ensure that any dust is kept to an absolute minimum. If residents believe that the mound is creating dust they should collect a sample and immediately inform the Environment Health Department at the Borough Council or let Cllr Burnett or myself know. The Department will collect any sample and analyse it to determine its source. If gypsum dust is found then the Environmental Health Department will work with Fernwood to resolve the problem.

WATNALL CORNER

Work to install a mini roundabout should begin shortly. There has been a delay because some of the utility services under the road have had to be realigned and the utility company has been slow in doing the necessary work.
