This is a very short email about the plans for an Open Cast coal mine at Shortwood Farm.

There is some encouraging news today; the Secretary of State, Eric Pickles has extended the time period during which he will consider "calling in" Notts County Council's decision to grant planning permission to UK Coal. Press reports this morning suggested that Eric had already called in the decision much to UK Coal's disappointment! If only.

I have already spoken to Eric about the decision, wrote formally asking him to call it in before Christmas and am meeting him on Monday afternoon.
